

H. H. Hudgens, farmer and stock raiser, section 20, post office Unionville, Iowa was born Oct. 16, 1811, in Cumberland County, Virginia and migrated to Williamson County, Illinois in 1845 where he lived until 1847 when he came to Davis County, arriving in Bloomfield in June. He lived there until 1848 when he moved to his present farm. Mr. Hudgens was a member of the first Board of Supervisors in Davis County elected by the Democratic Party. He has been a prosperous farmer and an honored citizen. He has been a member of the Protestant Methodist Church for a good many years. His farm is located on North Soap Creek and contains 120 acres of land well improved, watered and fenced. He was married November 10, 1836 to Miss Susan Harrison, a native of Tennessee. They have eight children: William C., Thomas J., Lucian B., Mary J., (wife of Hiram Clark of Appanoose County), James M., George W., and John M., (living at home), and Rebecca, (wife of H. H. Whiseler of Fremont County).

Grandfather Hudgens - Born in Virginia, near the city of Culpepper in Culpepper County and migrated with his parents when young to Marion County, Illinois near Jonesborough. Many Hudgens are now about Jonesborough, Herring and Matton. I don't know his father's or mother's names, but he had a brother, Jim. Grandmother was born in Tennessee and migrated with her parents to Illinois where she married grandpa. I don't know her father's or mother's first names or at what age she did migrate to Illinois but her maiden name was Harrison, a cousin of President W. H. Harrison and 4th cousin of President Ben H. Harrison. After Grandmother's mother passed away her father married again and there were two or three children born to this union, one son's name was William. Great Grandfather Hudgens once was a slave holder, but liberated his slaves before the Civil War. He was reported to have been wealthy. Henry Hudgens was born Oct. 16, 1811; died May 28, 1885. Grandma Hudgens was born \_\_\_\_\_; died January 19, 1889. Henry Hudgens and Susan Harrison married November 17, 1836.

William C. Hudgens, farmer and stock raiser of Section 18 Post Office Unionville, Iowa was born in Williamson County, Illinois January 15, 1838 where he lived until he was ten years old, when his parents moved to Davis County, Iowa. He was raised on a farm and educated in the common schools. His farm is located on Soap Creek and contains 240 acres of which 180 is under cultivation. He was married Oct 13, 1861, to Miss Angeline Nolan, a native of Kentucky and they have nine children all living at home: Frances, John H., Thomas, Susan M., Samuel, Eliza Jane, Eldora, Bertha L., and Adith.
