Beginning at the Northwest Corner of Thomas Hails forty acre survey S86E50 links, to a Black Oak 24 inches diameter, North 25E32 links, to a Dogwood 9 inches diameter Thence West 206. to a stake S77E10 links to an Elm 9 inches diameter Thence South 206. chains to a stake in a field Thence East 20 chains to a stake S56.E32 links to an Ash 15 inches diameter, N58E28 links to a Sweet Gum 15 inches diameter, Thence North 20 chains to the beginning containing forty acres to have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land with all accessories, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Hudgens his heirs and assigns and the said Thomas Loudon and Sally Loudon for themselves their heirs &C* do covenant and agree to and with the said Henry H.
