# VOLUNTEER ENLISTMENT.

State of Iowa  Town of Unionville  
I, Lucian B. Hudgens born in Williamson County  
in the State of Illinois aged nineteen years, and by  
occupation a Farmer Do HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE to have  
volunteered this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1862, to serve

as a SOLDIER in the ARMY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, for the period of Three Years, unless sooner dis-  
charged by proper authority: Do also agree to accept such bounty, pay, rations and clothing as are, or may be estab-  
lished by law for volunteers. And I, Lucian B. Hudgens,  
do solemnly swear, that I will bear true and faithful allegiance to the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, and that I  
will serve them honestly and faithfully against all their enemies or opposers whomsoever; and that I will observe and  
obey the orders of the President of the United States, and the orders of the officers appointed over me, according to the  
Rules and Articles of War.

strictly observed the Regulations which govern the recruiting service in this case.
